Sub: Regarding designation, appointment, promotion etc. of faculty in pharmacy institutions - reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to state that 116th Central Council of the PCI in its meeting held on 29th July, 2022–

- a) decided that UGC's following Regulation and subsequent amendments from time to time shall be followed by pharmacy institutions with regard to designation, appointment, promotion etc. of faculty -
 - UGC (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) Regulations, 2010 and various amendments there to from time to time.
- b) It was further noted that UGC Regulations do not cover D.Pharm course. In view of it, there shall be separate Regulations with regard to "Minimum qualification for teachers in D.Pharm institutions" and in the meanwhile since Diploma in Pharmacy is after 10+2, hence for D.Pharm faculty, institutions may follow the B.Pharm regulations teachers norms for appointment and promotion.
