
Sub: Criminal Case against the institution if they submit fraudulent documents to PCI.

Sir/Madam

1. With reference to the subject cited above, it is stated that-
 - a) Section 12(3) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 empowers the PCI to seek any information/document as required to the course of study, training and examination.
 - b) Accordingly the PCI seeks the information in SIF and other details as required from time to time.
2. In this connection, it may please be noted that institutions are required to submit correct information to PCI.
3. Please note in case wrong information / fraudulent documents are submitted to the PCI, the PCI can file criminal case against the Principal, Chairman/Secretary of the trust/society/company of the institution for submitting wrong information/fraudulent documents with malafide intentions to mislead the PCI.
